NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **Tuesday, June 9, 2026**, at **4:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter as the matter shall be heard, a public hearing will be conducted in the City Council Chamber at 100 Civic Center Drive, Newport Beach. The City Council of Newport Beach will consider the following:

The City's proposed **2025 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP)** and **2025 Water Shortage Contingency Plan (WSCP)** in advance of their proposed adoption.

The public hearing is being held in accordance with the Urban Water Management Planning Act (California Water Code Sections 10610 through 10656; herein referred to as the "Act"). The Act requires "every urban water supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually" to prepare, adopt, and file a UWMP with the California Department of Water Resources and review and update its UWMP every five years. The purpose of the public hearing will be to solicit public comment prior to adoption of the proposed updated UWMP and WSCP.

We encourage our customers and residents to review the plans. The 2025 UWMP, and 2025 WSCP are available on the City's web site at <https://www.newportbeachca.gov/government/departments/utilities> and at the City Clerk's office located on the second floor Bay E at 100 Civic Center Drive, Newport Beach, CA.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN The project is exempt under Section 15060(c)(2). Of the State CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) Guidelines because it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

All interested parties may appear and present testimony regarding this change. If you challenge this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you raised at the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the City, at, or prior to, the public hearing. The change may be continued to a specific future meeting date, and if such an action occurs, additional public notice of the continuance will not be provided. Prior to the public hearing, the agenda, staff report, Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan documents may be reviewed at the City Clerk's Office, at 100 Civic Center Drive, Newport Beach, California, 92660 or at the City of Newport Beach website at www.newportbeachca.gov. Individuals not able to attend the meeting may contact the Utilities Department or access the City's website after the meeting to review the action on this item.
