I am a resident in Cameo Shores whose family struggles to make phone calls. Both my wife and I are physicians and frequently miss important phone calls from the hospital. In addition, while our kids are enjoying the beach, they're unable to make phone calls in case of need.

Reliable wireless communication is essential public infrastructure. In a coastal community like Newport Beach, strong cellular coverage plays a critical role in emergency preparedness, public safety, and disaster response. During coastal flooding, severe storms, wildfires, major traffic incidents, or evacuation events, residents and visitors increasingly rely on mobile devices to receive emergency alerts, access evacuation routes, contact family members, and communicate with first responders.

Newport Beach welcomes millions of visitors annually, and wireless networks are often strained during peak weekends, holidays, and special events. Expanding and modernizing telecommunications infrastructure will help ensure that emergency communications remain reliable when they are needed most.

I encourage the City Council to adopt policies that facilitate the responsible deployment of wireless facilities while maintaining appropriate aesthetic and design standards. By doing so, Newport Beach can strengthen public safety, improve emergency preparedness, and ensure reliable communications for residents and visitors alike.
