In 1964, Captain Bergay enlisted in the US Marine Corps after attending Oakland City College in Oakland, CA. There he minored in Aeronautics. While with the Corps he trained as a controller and attended Northrop Institute, again in his pursuit of a career in aviation. Also, while on active duty as a Marine, Captain Bergay soloed a Cessna 150 out of Santa Monica airport on March 9, 1965. Thus began his long and varied career in aviation.

In 1969 he was honorable discharged from the Marine Corps. Soon thereafter, he entered the US Army Flight Training program and was commissioned a Warrant Officer. After two years active duty, he remained in the Army Reserves and CA National Guard until 1995. Having served as an aircraft dispatcher with Los Angeles Airways (helicopter), he worked at Air California Airlines in that capacity and was subsequently hired as a pilot with Air Cal where he flew the L-188 Electra and B-737. Since Air Cal was acquired by American, Captain Bergay has flown the SBO, DC10, B757/767 and is retiring as a captain on the Boeing 777.
