TITLE: Harbormaster Update, September 2018 and Year in Review

ABSTRACT:

The Harbormaster is responsible for on-water management of the City's moorings, the Marina Park Marina and code enforcement on the water. This report will update the Commission on the Harbor Department's activities for September, 2018. In addition, the Harbormaster will provide the Commission with a review of the first year of operation.
