

As Vice Chair of the City Arts Commission, I would like to recommend that Chair Arlene Greer be permitted to remain on the Arts Commission for another year.

Aside from Arlene and myself, the Arts Commission is comprised of newer commissioners. We are all bright and capable members, I am not in a position to take on the role as Chair for the upcoming year, and the other commissioners have expressed they are not yet ready to take on this leadership role.

Over the past year, the Arts Commission has experienced a number of changes, combined with our respective committee responsibilities that we are working through. Several months ago, Tim began transitioning Natalie Basmaciyani into the role of overseeing the Arts Commission. Last September, the City's long-time event planner, Janis Dinwiddie retired. We were assigned an event planner for our upcoming events just a couple of weeks ago for the Sculpture Garden IV Opening and Newport Beach Art Exhibition. We recently had one of the arts commissioners resign, and just last month the city council appointed a new commissioner to fill that unplanned vacancy.
