

Item IV.d. Discuss Agenda Items for Next Meeting

This seems similar to Item V, in which committee members may request items for future agendas *without* discussion.

It is good to see this discussion planned, provided it is limited to choosing next meeting topics and not used to resolve them at this meeting, or to forever exclude any matters from further discussion without notifying the public of what is might be discussed under this heading.

As to topics for the next meeting, since the present committee owes its existence to a recommendation of the City Council's earlier General Plan Update Steering Committee, I think it would be good to hear a summary of any conclusions reached by that prior committee.

I think a discussion of committee member conflicts of interest will likely also be needed, sooner rather than later. That should include whether disclosures should go beyond the bare minimum required by California's Political Reform Act. For example, should there be disclosure if a committee recommendation will benefit a former business associate?
