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Barbara,

In the Civil Service Board draft minutes for Oct. 5, 2020, posted this morning (Item V.1.a on the November 2, 2020, agenda), I am unable to guess the meaning of the final part of the first "Fire Prevention" bullet on page 3 of 5:

"Sixty-three violation notices were emailed out on October 1, 2020, for wildland inspections; **101** out of **276** with property violations."

The most likely guess would seem to be that the two parts together were intended to say something like: "101 property violations have been found in 276 wildland inspections, for which, on October 1, notices were sent regarding 63 of those violations."

But that's only a guess, for it seems equally plausible the second part was reporting on something different from the first, such as that over some longer period of time 101 notices were sent out in connection with 276 violations detected.

In short, the meaning of the piece in bold, above, is quite unobvious to me.
