

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on **Thursday, May 06, 2021**, at **6:30 p.m.** or soon thereafter as the matter shall be heard, a public hearing will be conducted in the Council Chambers at 100 Civic Center Drive, Newport Beach. The Planning Commission of the City of Newport Beach will consider the following application:

Super Panga Restaurant – A request for a conditional use permit to remodel and expand an existing restaurant into the abutting tenant space, currently occupied by Henry's Groceries. Also included is a request to upgrade the existing Type 41 (On-Sale Beer and Wine - Eating Place) Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license to a Type 47 (On-Sale General - Eating Place) ABC license. As part of the project, the existing Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer and Wine) ABC license held by Henry's Groceries will be eliminated. The proposed expansion will create an enlarged interior dining area, as well as improved kitchen and restroom facilities. The proposed hours of operation are from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m., Monday through Thursday, and 6 a.m. to 1:30 a.m., Friday through Sunday.

The project is categorically exempt under Section 15301, of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines - Class 1 (Existing Facilities).

All interested parties may appear and present testimony regarding this application. If you challenge this project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you raised at the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the City, at, or prior to, the public hearing. Administrative procedures for appeals are provided in the Newport Beach Municipal Code Chapter 20.64 (Appeals). The application may be continued to a specific future meeting date, and if such an action occurs, additional public notice of the continuance will not be provided.
