11. Multiple Vessel Mooring System. The term "multiple vessel mooring system" shall mean a floating platform secured to a single or double anchor <u>mooring</u> system which allows multiple vessels to be secured that are <u>equal to or</u> shorter in overall length than the side of the platform to which the vessels are to be moored.

c. Multiple Vessel Mooring System Program. The Harbor <u>Department master</u> may approve a multiple vessel mooring system in the <u>single anchor</u> mooring areas of Newport Harbor. An application and applicable fee, established by resolution of the City Council, for a multiple vessel mooring system shall be submitted in writing to the Harbor <u>Department master</u>, who shall evaluate the application based upon standards established and the application shall be approved if the Harbor <u>Department master</u> makes the findings under the applicable standards and those set forth in Section 17.05.140(D)(1).
