## RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 83

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, CALIFORNIA, PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING ON SEGMENTS OF FORD ROAD BETWEEN NEWPORT HILLS DRIVE WEST AND THE WEST END OF FORD ROAD

WHEREAS, Section 200 of the City of Newport Beach ("City") Charter vests the City Council with the authority to make and enforce all laws, rules and regulations with respect to municipal affairs subject only to the restrictions and limitations contained in the Charter and the State Constitution, and power to exercise, or act pursuant to any and all rights, powers, and privileges, or procedures granted or prescribed by any law of the State of California;

WHEREAS, Section 12.44.160 (Prohibited Night Parking) of the Newport Beach Municipal Code ("NBMC") provides that the City Council shall designate by resolution, the streets or portions of streets on which the parking or standing of vehicles after six p.m. and before six a.m. the next day is prohibited;

WHEREAS, Section 12.44.160 of the NBMC further requires the City Council resolution to designate the days of the week and the exact hours during which such prohibition shall be in effect; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to prohibit overnight parking as hereinafter provided.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Newport Beach hereby resolves as follows:

**Section 1:** The parking of vehicles is prohibited on Ford Road from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily in the roadway segments described below and depicted in Exhibit "A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference:

- South side of Ford Road between Newport Hills Drive West and the west end of Ford Road, and
- North side of Ford Road between 250 feet west of Newport Hills Drive West and the west end of Ford Road.

**Section 2:** The City Traffic Engineer shall place and maintain signs giving notice of such prohibition.

**Section 3:** The recitals provided in this resolution are true and correct and are incorporated into the operative part of this resolution.

**Section 4:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 5:** The City Council finds the adoption of this resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15060(c)(3) (the activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378) of the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Division 6, Chapter 3, because it has no potential for resulting in physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly.

**Section 6:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting the resolution.
