a) Hold a public hearing regarding the renewal of the Newport Beach Restaurant Association Business Improvement District for Fiscal Year 2020-21.

b-1) If the protests received are less than 50 percent of the total assessment amount, adopt Resolution No. 2020-65, *A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Newport Beach, California, Confirming the Levying of Assessment for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 for the Newport Beach Restaurant Association Business Improvement District;*

or

b-2) If the protests received are 50 percent or more of the total assessment amount, abandon the proceedings to renew the Newport Beach Restaurant Association Business Improvement District.

c) Determine this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15060(c)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines because this action will not result in a physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly; and
